## Covid-19: Key sector dates and milestones

20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 – Gym and leisure facilities close across the UK

25<sup>th</sup> March 2020 – ukactive urge chancellor to provide financial support for self-employed

13<sup>th</sup> April 2020 – ukactive issue urgent call to restrict tactics used by landlords coercing gym/leisure centres into paying rent.

23rd April 2020 – ukactive set out four-stage strategy to support reopening

5<sup>th</sup> May 2020 – ukactive identifies 5 key areas for policy support: workforce; support to rebuild; local authority leisure providers; rent; children and young people.

7<sup>th</sup> May 2020 – ukactive unveils recommended framework for reopening

13<sup>th</sup> May 2020 – questioning over job retention scheme

19<sup>th</sup> May 2020 – Greg Whyte writes blog outlining the crucial role our sector will play in the nation's recovery from Covid-19

21<sup>st</sup> May 2020 – ukactive's Huw Edwards joins MPs and sector leads to discuss the impact on physical activity sector

29<sup>th</sup> May 2020 – ukactive calls for collaboration with devolved governments to support reopening of the sector

8<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – Lobbying to extend the protection of the sector by extending the Insolvency Bill and to scrap the Stamp Duty Land Tax during lockdown.

17<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – ukactive join leisure, hospitality and retail sector in call for urgent extension of rent protection

29<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – ukactive and Community Leisure UK write to every MP to call on central government to ring-fence funding for public leisure providers

1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 – Facilitating government visits to leisure sites prior to reopening ensuring public health officials are comfortable with changes the sector has adopted.

4<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – Baroness Tanni Grey-Thompson (Chair of ukactive) pens a letter to the Prime Minister Boris Johnson urging clarity and support for our sector

7<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – CEO Huw Edwards gives evidence at DCMS Select Committee regarding the effect of Covid-19 on the sector

 $8^{\text{th}}$  July 2020 – ukactive calls for government stimulus package for the physical activity sector

 $9^{th}$  July 2020 – announcement of legal reopening of indoor gym and leisure facilities in England will occur  $25^{th}$  July

10<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – Gyms and leisure centres in Northern Ireland reopen

13<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – Baroness TGT pens op-ed in *The Telegraph* titled "We need a e need a fundamental change in the way physical activity is valued' to highlight tole of the sector in supporting positive outcomes in the UK going forward

14<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – Called for review of taxation and regulatory measures. The industry requires more investment to recover and grow – calling government for workout from work scheme 25<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – Indoor gyms reopen in England

25<sup>th</sup> July 2020 – ukactive begins weekly data updates to Governments on Covid-rates in facilities

- 30<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Calls for clarification on reopening in Scotland
- 30<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Announcement of legal reopening of gyms and leisure centres in Wales to take place 10<sup>th</sup> August
- 5<sup>th</sup> August 2020 Statement from ukactive supporting gyms and localised lockdown in Bradford
- 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020 Gyms reopen in Wales
- 20<sup>th</sup> August 2020 Announcement of legal reopening of gym and leisure facilities in Scotland on 31<sup>st</sup> August
- 31st August 2020 Gyms reopen in Scotland
- 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020 Following requests from ukactive, Welsh Government drops '30-person limit' inside facilities
- 1st October 2020 Steam rooms and saunas open in England
- 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020 Government announces gyms and leisure centres can remain open in Tier 3
- 31st October 2020 England-wide lockdown announced for month of November, gyms and leisure centres to close
- 9<sup>th</sup> November 2020 Gyms and leisure centres re-open in Wales following 'firebreak' lockdown
- 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020 ukactive briefs MPs ahead of debate on petition to keep gyms open
- 20<sup>th</sup> December 2020 Tier 4 announced for parts of England, closing gyms and leisure centres
- 20<sup>th</sup> December 2020 Wales announces March-style lockdown, gyms and leisure centres to close
- 26<sup>th</sup> December 2020 Scotland announces lockdown for mainland, gyms and leisure centres close
- 29<sup>th</sup> December 2020 ukactive writes to all MPs urging them to support physical activity centres
- $4^{\text{th}}$  January 2020 England announces nationwide lockdown, all gyms and leisure centres to close.
